The Organisers

The film fest is organized by Centre for Culture and media Studies in associated with Pondicherry University in which Moon Tv is associated as Media Partner to telecast the films. Centre for Culture and Media Studies was promoted by a team of qualified professionals from Print and Electronic media based in Trichy and Chennai, Tamil Nadu, India.

Theme :

Films based on Cultural themes related to south Indian Culture, traditions, cultural values etc.,

Aims and Objectives

The purpose of "South Indian Culture to Fame" is to encourage creative thinking on Culture, bringing out disappeared cultured values and to build awareness on the need to move towards a society that is inclusive for everyone.

Certificates will be issued to all participants jointly by Pondicherry University and Centre for Culture and Media Studies.

Eligibility

- The competition is open to all filmmakers
- The entry can be animation, live action or both.

- The running time including credits (how many to be included is left to the discretion of the filmmaker), should not exceed more than 5 minutes and not less than 3 minutes.
- The production could be either in Film / Video or in Digital format, but the entries should be submitted on Mpeg 1 or Mpeg 2 Format or in HD format.
- The entry should not have been publicly shown either on television or in theatre before.
- Films of own by individuals are only eligible
- Proper acknowledgement to be obtain after submitting the film.
- Entry should be made available to the Director, Moon TV, 37/9, Chamiers Tower, Teynampet, IIIrd Floor, Chennai – 600 018. On or before August 25th 2016.

Screenings

The Films that are accepted for competition will be screened in Pondicherry University Auditorium in September 2016. The applicant will be informed of the date and time of screening.

Films will be categorized into two categories.

- (a). Films eligible for only screening during the festival
- (b). Films eligible for special screening. (i.e., Special screening films are of more standard in nature than films eligible in ordinary screening in respect of theme, contents and making.

Telecast

The films which are received for the festival will be telecast in Moon Tv for which an entry fee of Rs. 1000/- to be pay by way of Demand Draft drawn on Trichy, in favour of Centre for Culture and Media Studies. This would be more useful for the participants where they can get more response from the viewers.

Entry Documents

Each entry must be submitted separately and must include the following:

1. Not more than one title can be entered in a single entry form.

2. A maximum of 3 entries only will be accepted from each individual applicant
3. Each film should be attached with minimum two photographs of the shooting location
4. Each film CD should be labelled with the title, filmmaker's name, running time, and contact number and should be sent to Moon TV.
6. Completed and signed entry form;
7. Three copies of a passport size photograph of the filmmaker;
8. Self-addressed stamped envelope for entry acknowledgement.

The films that are accepted for "*South Indian Culture to Fame!*" will remain with the organisers and will not be returned. Those not accepted for competition, however, will be returned on request.

Rights : All the entries which are accepted for Special screening will be duly awarded in the form of Cheque / DD. However, all films accepted for Screening will be property of Centre for Culture and Media Studies.

1. Submit of movie based on your original storybile phone to a professional camera, to make your movie with in the prescribed duration.
2. By submitting, if chosen as an official selection, you are hereby granting permission for Centre for Culture and media Studies and Moon TV to exhibit your submission
3. You have to submit the film to Centre for Culture and Media Studies. You may not submit another person's work as your own. If you are under the age of eighteen (18), you must have your parent or legal guardian submit your film on your behalf.
4. Submissions will be rejected if received after the posted submission dates.
5. There is no restriction on the number of movies you may submit to the festival. Each movie must be submitted separately.
6. Only completed projects will be accepted. We will not accept rough cuts of films, nor will we accept trailers of feature projects. Your submission must be a complete and final.
7. We do not accept submissions that have premiered elsewhere and films available for viewing on YouTube, Google Video, ifilm, or other free online sites will also not accepted.
8. Submission format: we prefer that you submit your film in MPEG 1 or MPEG 2 format.
9. Film Fest is open genre; we accept all forms and genres that would be deemed within a G, PG, PG-13, R, or NC-17 rating by our screening committee and jurors. The content of your film must not be obscene, pornographic, invade privacy rights, exploit the images of individuals under the age of eighteen (18), or in any other way violate applicable laws and regulations.
10. You must have the right to use all of the images and music in your film. Organizers

is not responsible for any claims and rights of the copyright holders, if any, in literary, dramatic, musical or other material, including stories, plays, scripts, scenarios, themes, incidents, plots, characteristics, dialogue, music, words appearing, used or recorded in your film.
